Located in the Higashi Tanzawa area, this 65ha forest park is the 3rd largest of its kind in Kanagawa Prefecture. Chokoku-ji is a historic temple that can be traced back to the 8th Century, with beautiful cherry blossoms in spring. hydrangeas in early summer, and maple trees in fall. The Kannon Hall, added in the mid-18th Century, is dedicated to the Eleven-faced Kannon, and its statue is housed in the Hall. Known for being a "matchmaking" temple, the lucky charms blessed at the temple are perfect souvenirs.

Atsugi Ayu Festival is one of the 50 best festivals in Kanagawa. The firework display on Saturday is the largest of its kind in the prefecture, and approximately 10,000 fireworks light up the sky. In addition to Ayu (sweetfish)
