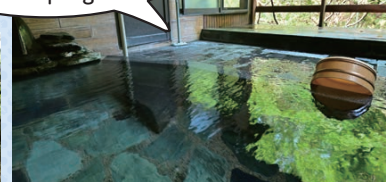

## NANASAWA FOREST PARK

### A perfect opportunity to enjoy nature

Located in the Higashi Tanzawa area, this 65ha forest park is the 3rd largest of its kind in Kanagawa Prefecture. There is a nature walk trail for the beginners, and an observation deck where you can easily enjoy the scenic view. From March till November, there is a BBQ area, where you can bring your own food or show up empty-handed.

## TREE CROSS ADVENTURE

### Family fun!

Tree Cross Adventure extends over 25,000m<sup>2</sup> on a hilly terrain, and offers 10 types of thrilling adventure courses. For the first 8 courses you can choose from either intermediate or advanced levels. The main attraction is the 173m long zip line that crosses a 30m deep valley. They also have a kids' adventure course for smaller children aged between 3-8 years old.

## MT. OYAMA

Mt. Oyama (1,252m) is popular amongst the locals as well as tourists. You can take the cable car to Afuri Shrine, which is mid-way up the mountain. Tourists flock here especially during the spring green season and the fall foliage. The spectacular view you can enjoy from Afuri Shrine is rated 2 stars on the *Japanese Michelin Green Guide*.



## MIYAGASE DAM

Miyagase Dam releases water for 6 min, creating a spectacular 70m water fall. This water show draws in families and couples on a date as the fall creates splashes and mists, adding to the excitement. There are plenty of activities such as scenic ferry ride on the lake to road train in Aikawa Park which is a hit with the children.

## Iiyama HAKUSAN FOREST PARK

## Iiyama KANNON CHOKOKUJI TEMPLE

### This famous temple is listed on the Prefecture's Top 50 scenic views

Chokoku-ji is a historic temple that can be traced back to the 8th Century, with beautiful cherry blossoms in spring, hydrangeas in early summer, and maple trees in fall. The Kannon Hall, added in the mid-18th Century, is dedicated to the Eleven-faced Kannon, and its statue is housed in the Hall. Known for being a "matchmaking" temple, the lucky charms blessed at the temple are perfect souvenirs.

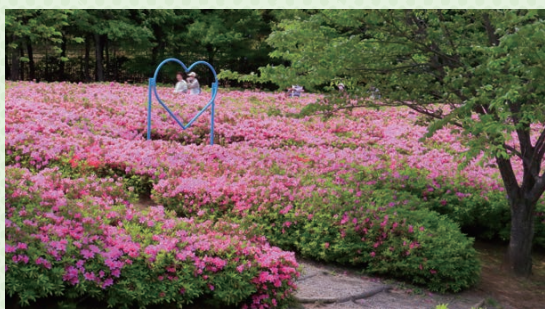

In addition to Ayu (sweetfish) catching event for kids, there is also a Mikoshi (portable shrine) parade, dance contest and more.

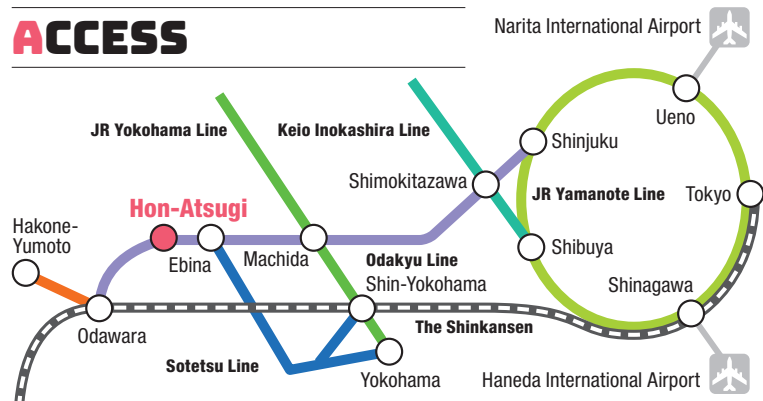
